Baseline Emissions Footprint

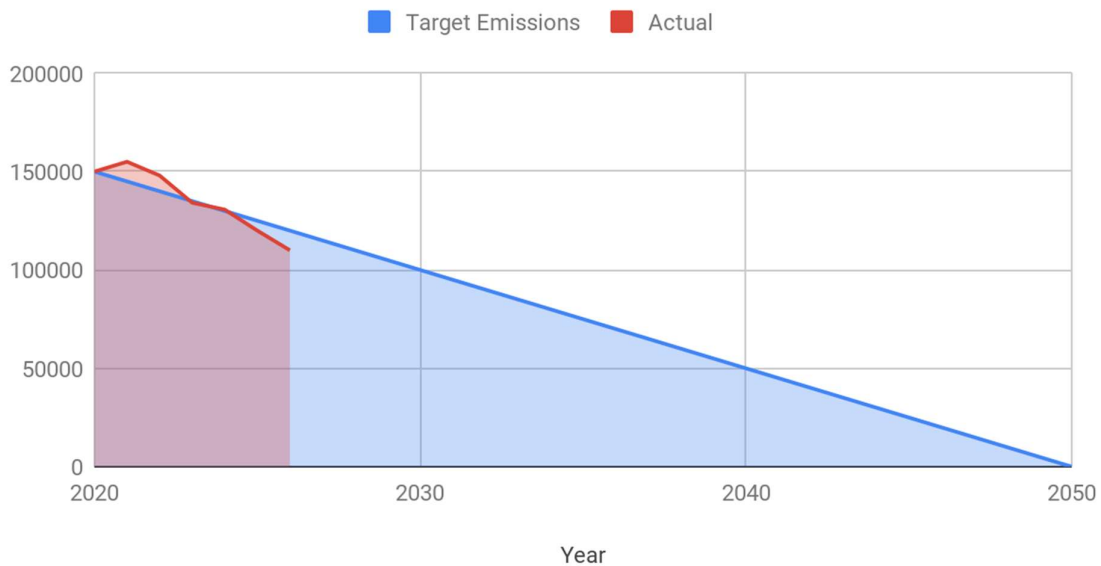
Baseline Year: 2030	
Ascendant Lifts Ltd. have not previously assessed or reported on emissions. Therefore, we have used our first reporting period as our baseline. Prior to this, there was no formal reporting of emissions, including Scope 3 emissions. This baseline is set following a significant organisational restructuring aimed at enhancing our sustainability practices.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2030 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equates to 130 tCO₂e, a 10% reduction against the 2030 baseline, and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract:

- Certification Schemes: We have achieved a ISO14001 certification.
- Energy Efficiency: Installed LED lighting in all offices, reducing energy consumption by 50 tCO2e annually.
- Travel Policy: Implemented a policy reducing company travel and flights, saving 40 tCO2e annually.
- Waste Management: Adopted a zero to landfill policy, cutting emissions by 10 tCO2e annually.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Fleet Electrification: Begin the electrification of the company vehicle fleet, reducing emissions by 30 tCO2e annually.
- Renewable Energy: Transitioning to 100% renewable energy sources for all operations.
- Sustainable Procurement: Enhancing sustainable procurement policies to include only suppliers with strong environmental credentials.
- Advanced Recycling Programs: Introducing advanced recycling programs to further reduce waste.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting.
