What Are LOLER Inspections?

LOLER inspections are legally mandated assessments aimed at ensuring that lifting equipment, including lifts and hoists, is safe for use.

Introduced under the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 (LOLER), these inspections are crucial for identifying potential defects or issues that could jeopardise the safety of the equipment and its users.

As a duty holder under LOLER, if you are responsible for the safe operation of any lift, you bear the legal responsibility to ensure it undergoes thorough examinations on a regular basis.

This applies to all passenger lifts, goods lifts, and service lifts.

Key Points About LOLER Inspections:

Regular Inspections: Passenger lifts must be thoroughly examined every 6 months, while goods lifts require inspections every 12 months. These regular checks are essential for verifying that the lifts remain safe and fully operational.

Competent Examiners: The inspections must be conducted by a 'competent person'—an individual or organization with the necessary expertise and independence to accurately assess the lift's safety and compliance.

Duty of Care: As a lift operator or owner, you have a duty of care to ensure that every lift under your responsibility is examined according to the LOLER guidelines. Failure to comply can result in severe legal consequences and, more importantly, compromise the safety of the lift's users.
